Grant Applications will be by invitation only, closing February 2020.

Successful applicants will be notified March 2020.

- Summary of what new knowledge or data is to be generated
- How the project will deliver new, practical policy insights and impact, drawing on interdisciplinary research

Outline of proposed research methodology.

3. Timeframe for the research and key deliverables

Note: the project must reach completion within 12 months upon receipt of signed funding agreement. There is **not** flexibility with this timeframe.

4. Budget

Outline of how the proposed budget meets the output and delivery timeframe.

5. Results and practical policy implications (500 words max)
